TUITION & FEE INFORMATION

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

GRADE	ANNUAL TUITION
Grade 9-12	\$49,000

To secure your spot, a \$5,000 non-refundable tuition deposit is required.

Applicants may be eligible for special consideration under the following circumstances:

- One visa denial occurring within three months prior to the program start date; or
- Two visa denials occurring more than three months prior to the program start date.
- Official documentation of each visa denial must be submitted for review.

Registration Fee (Non-Refundable) <i>This non-refundable fee secures the student's enrollment and covers enrollment processing, student records setup, administrative services, and new student onboarding.</i>	\$1,800
I-20 Processing Fee (Non-Refundable)	\$2,000
Student Health Insurance <i>Health insurance is required for all international students. They will be automatically enrolled in a health insurance policy for the year.</i>	\$3,400
Graduation Fee: <i>This fee is a one-time non-refundable fee in grade 12.</i>	\$600
Uniforms <i>All students are required to purchase their own uniforms</i>	\$500

Boarding Program	\$35,000/Y
Homestay Program	\$40,000/Y
Application Fee <i>This fee is charged only once, during the student's first year in the housing program.</i>	\$550
Security Deposit <i>The security deposit is fully refundable after the student leaves the housing program, provided no damage or loss has occurred in the dormitory or homestay.</i>	\$1,100
Boarding Extension Fee after last day	\$130/Day
Homestay Extension Fee after last day	\$150/Day
Lunch Program	\$650/Semester \$1,300/Y

Self-Arranged Housing Compliance and Safety Management Fee	\$2,600/Y
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This annual fee covers, but is not limited to, the following services:

- Review and documentation of the student's self-arranged housing information;
- Background check and related documentation for the host family or local housing arrangement;
- Collection, verification, and maintenance of the student's local residential address, guardian/contact information, and emergency contact information;
- One housing visit or housing condition check per semester;
- Basic safety review of the housing environment;
- Ongoing maintenance of housing records and necessary information updates throughout the school year.

Housing Change Re-Review Fee	\$600
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If the student changes **host family** or **local residential address** during the school year, the family must notify the school in advance. Each change of host family or residential address will be subject to an additional \$600 Housing Change Re-Review Fee, which covers the necessary re-review of housing information, updates to the student's records, compliance record maintenance, and related follow-up work.
